Directions:

From Warrenton: Take 29 North about 5 miles. Just past the New Baltimore Fire Station make a left on Rt 674. Go about ½ mile and the road forks. bear to the right. We are about 1.5 miles ahead on the left. Red brick house with white columns and black board fencing. There is a row of white pines across the front of the house and a bronze colored horse trailer parked behind the white pines.

From Gainesville: Take 29 south about 5 miles. Go through the traffic light at Rt 600 and then make the next right on Rt 674. Proceed as above.

From Rt 55 and The Plains: Take Rt 55 east toward Haymarket. About 5 miles from the Plains 55 passes under I-66 and the road will be divided. Turn right on Rt.674. Go about ½ mile and 674 will make a left turn. turn left and continue about 3 miles. You

will cross a bridge where the road narrows slightly. To the right you will see a riding ring with white board fence (the rest of the property has black fence). This is the place. 6156 Georgetown Road.
